## ALL 2021 CAMPS CANCELLED

The Board of Directors met at Camp and via Zoom on May 1 to decide whether to operate this summer. New York State's Department of Health had given no guidelines/regulations for overnight camps as of that date. The Board unanimously felt that there was inadequate time to prepare and execute a plan for camp that would meet whatever requirements they propose. (They still haven't as of this writing.)

Every board member expressed sadness at having to reach this decision. They immediately set in motion plans to have opportunities for Camp's use in different ways. Please see the next article.

Both Camp Agape and St. George Family Camp had previously cancelled their 2021 camp programs, citing similar reasons to CHC's.

## 2020-21 BUDGET

As you can imagine, two years of camp not being used has had a huge impact on Camp's budgets. Last year the income budget was estimated to be \$32650, but actual income was \$17042. The expense budget was \$28330 and actual expenses were 18,801 for a net deficit of \$1759. If it were not for the faithful support of all of you, that deficit would have been much larger. As you know, certain expenses exist whether or not camp is used (insurance, maintenance, utilities, pool upkeep, etc.).

When the 2020-21 budget was approved the plan and hope was that camps would be in session this summer. Once again CHC will not have income from the normal camp rentals and camper registrations meaning that nearly all income will be from donations. It cannot be said enough how important you are to the continued existence of CHC! Thank you!!
